ADDENDUM TO GDCE NOTIFICATION -2024

<u>ADDENDUM</u>

The following sub-clause(s) is added to Sl.No: 19 of GDCE Notification No: SER/P-HQ/RRC/GDCE/2024 dated: 13/05/2024.

Sl.No. 19.2 should be read as Sl.No. 19.2 (a).

Sl.No. 19.2 (b) (for candidates appearing for the post of ALP)

The Computer Based Test (CBT) shall have two parts viz. Part A and Part B as detailed below:

Total Duration: 2 hours and 30 Minutes (for Part A and Part B together)

<u>PART A</u> - No of Questions: 100, Duration - 90 Minutes(120 Minutes for eligible PwBD candidates accompanied with Scribe)

Minimum percentage of marks for eligibility in various categories: UR -40%, OBC-30%, SC-30%, ST -25%.

The marks scored in Part A alone shall be used for short listing of candidates for further stages of recruitment process subject to the condition that the candidate is securing qualifying mark in Part B.

<u>PART B -</u> No of Questions: 75, Duration-60 Minutes (80 Minutes for eligible PwBD candidates accompanied with scribe)

Qualifying Mark: 35% (This is applicable to all candidates and no relaxation is permissible) This part is qualifying in nature and shall have questions from the trade syllabus.

Those candidates whose Part B score is equal to or more than 35% are considered qualified.

Rank the qualified candidates shall be in the order of their PART A score.

If PART A score of two or more candidates is equal, then consider the date of birth. Candidate who is eldest as per date of birth will be ranked higher followed by other candidates having the same PART A score.

Computer Based Aptitude Test

Qualifying marks: The candidate needs to secure a minimum score of 42 marks in each of the test batteries to qualify. This is applicable to all candidates and no relaxation is permissible.

Candidates equal to 8 times number of ALP vacancies for each of the communities i.e. UR, OBC-NCL, SC and ST (including Ex. SM) shall be short listed for Computer Based AT (based on their performance in Part A of CBT subject to their qualifying the Part B of CBT.

Candidates will have to qualify in each of the test battery of Computer Based AT for considering them for the post of ALP. The Computer Based Aptitude Test shall have questions and answer options only in English and Hindi. There shall be no negative marking in Computer Based AT.

The ALP merit list will be drawn only from amongst the candidates qualifying in the Aptitude Test, with 70% weightage for the marks obtained in the Part A of CBT and 30% weightage for the marks obtained in Computer Based AT.

Candidates are advised to visit websites of RDSO (www.rdso.indianrailways.gov.in -> Directorates -> Psycho Technical Directorate -> Candidates Corner) for question patterns and other details of AT.

Syllabus for CBT & CBAT

The syllabus for the CBT & CBAT (Aptitude Test) shall be the same as RRB examinations for direct recruitment from open market.
